Thank you for your interest in Summer 2024. The Summer Program follows a relaxed and entertaining variety of themes with daily arts and crafts and music geared to the topic at hand. We also offer weekly field trips on Wednesdays starting WEEK TWO. A few reminders:

It is our policy to receive monthly payments in advance, historically post-dated cheques. E-transfers (mlcpfees@gmail.com) and cash are also accepted. As we staff based on registrations, payment for the submitted days will be expected on the due dates of July 2nd and August 1st. Adjustments to payments for these dates will not be considered after June 1st. Please indicate ONLY the days you know you will use. Additional days may be added at a later date – space permitting. The Infant fee schedule does not change from that of the core year. Please ask for a fee schedule if you are unsure.

Due to issues encountered last year with e-transfer payments, we find it necessary to update our deposit policy. Please be advised that this year's deposit is \$240.00 and should accompany the registration form no later than March 28th. The deposit is comprised of a non-refundable registration fee of \$40.00 and the remaining \$200.00 will be applied equally to the outstanding fees in the month(s) attended. Should you decide not to attend after the June 1st deadline, the entire deposit will be non-refundable. Please note that all registrations received after March 28th will require a deposit of \$250.00 and space cannot be guaranteed. Confirmation of Summer Camp enrolment will be forwarded upon acceptance and receipt of deposit.

The day runs from 8:30am to 4:00pm with billed daycare hours between 7:30am and 8:00am and again between 4:30pm and 5:30pm. Complimentary daycare runs from 8-8:30am and 4-4:30pm. Daycare tickets are available from the daycare staff. Please ensure ticket purchase as the week-end billing is at a higher charge.

Prior to the commencement of Summer Camp, MLCP is required to confirm and pay for all Field Trip expenses which are based on student registration and, as such, are non-refundable.

Water Play is offered daily – please ensure that swimsuits, sunscreen, caps and towels are clearly labelled. Please check that all wet items are taken home at the end of each day and replaced with dry items for the next day's water fun.

General information remains the same – we suggest a couple of changes of labelled clothes be kept in backpacks for unexpected adventures. Out-door shoes, at this time of year, could be jellies or water shoes that fare well getting wet.

Snacks are provided daily. Please see posted menu each week.

Lunches are provided daily as mandated for all children under the age of 4. Optional hot lunch for children over the age of 4 is available for a nominal fee. Please ensure that lunches brought from home are healthy and well balanced as per the Health Department's request. As the school is NUT AWARE, please refrain from including food items that contain nuts – some granola bars, Nutella, peanut butter, etc. Lunch boxes cannot be stored in the fridge. Please use a thermos, ice pack or frozen juice box for temperature control. Your cooperation is appreciated.
