



TESTING

Formalized testing is not a historically accepted method of gauging accomplishment in a Montessori environment. Students work through curriculum encouraged to challenge and re-challenge themselves at each level.

Once reaching the Elementary level testing does begin as preparation for high school becomes more imminent.

The Canadian Test for Basic Skills is offered to students from 6 years old and over. The test is administered to Elementary students at the end of Term I and the end of Term III. Test results are available upon request and are filed in the Ontario Student Records.

Weekly spelling tests are administered from predetermined words at the Elementary level. Math computation tests are administered from the second year of the elementary programme. Weekly French tests begin at the Junior level again from a predetermined list for both core and Bi-lingual students. Senior Elementary students participate in unit tests as deemed necessary by the classroom and specialty teachers.
